Revenge Killing Reported MULHOUSE, France— West German guerrillas

said today they have killed kidnapped industrialist Hanns-Martin Schleyer and left his body in a green car parked in a Mulhouse street.

Police, working on a similar tip from West Germany, found a green Audi 100 automobile registered in Hamburg and fitting the description of the communique signed by

the Red Army Faction.

They said a preliminary check indicated there was no body in the car but they summoned explosives experts to open the trunk for fear it might be boobytrapped.

The communique said Schleyer has been killed in retaliation for the "massacre" of Mogasishu and Stannheim, referring to the killings of three Red Army hijackers in the rescue of the hostages from a hijacked Lufthansa jetliner in Somalia and the suicide of Red Army Faction leader Andreas Baader and two other revolutionaries in Stannheim prison outside Stuttgart.
