

Terrorist Gets 20 Year Term

Utrecht, Netherlands
—AP— A Dutch court has sentenced West German terrorist Knut Folkerts to 20 years in prison for killing a Dutch policeman and trying to kill another in a Sept. 22 shootout.

The 25 year old member of the **Red Army Faction** remained in his courthouse cell as presiding Judge Karel Bieger handed down the sentence. Folkerts said he was not interested in hearing the verdict.

Folkerts refused to answer questions at his trial and read only a long political statement at the end detailing the history and aims of the Red Army Faction.
