A witness sitting t in the nerby mess hall said he r heard two loud "whomps." I "After the first explosion P everyone seemed to sense there S would be another and people went diving for the floor," he ł I said. The military compound on the south side of Heidelberg j Î serves as headquarters for the U.S. Army forces in Europe. 1 The blast came 13 days after I another bombing at the U.S. Army V Corps headquarters base in Frankfurt. An Army colonel died in that explosion, and 13 other persons were At least four other explosions in various parts of West Germany during the past two weeks have been attributed by police to leftists. In Bonn Wednesday Interior Minister Dietrich Genscher said stopping the bombers was the number one task of the nation's e h Genscher told a news conferl, ence he had given the Cabinet a e report on the latest state of the r investigations against the bombers. He said he considered "the N fight against these criminal 1acts, which are directed against r the functional capabilities ıt our liberal, constitutional state, is now the most important and 1pressing task of the police." эŧ
