

Tiny West German Group Vows to Overthrow State

BERLIN, June 16—A small group of West German leftist political extremists has served notice that it plans to set up a guerrilla organization to overthrow the parliamentary system in the state and in West Berlin.

The group of three or four, headed by Ulrike Meinhof, a 36-year-old woman journalist, is believed to be in Beirut, Lebanon. They were said to have fled there June 8 after having freed a convict from prison while using guns.

The freed prisoner, Andreas Baader, sentenced to three years for setting fire to a Frankfurt department store, is believed to be with the group.

Miss Meinhof left a taped manifesto that proclaimed her plans, excerpts of which were printed this week in the Hamburg news magazine *Der Spiegel*. She said: "We must learn from the revolutionary movements of the world—the Vietcong, the Palestine Liberation Front, the Tupamaros, the Black Panthers."
