Schleyer Sought in Holland

THE HAGUE, Netherlands (UPI) — Heavily armed Dutch police today searched cars with West German license plates and kept watch for an overdue rented yacht in hopes of turning up kidnaped West German industrialist Hans-Martin Schleyer.

Justice ministry officials said they were searching for a yacht rented by West Germans but not returned the day it was due back. They would not say where or when the boat was rented.

Carbine-carrying police in bullet-proof vests searched cars with West German license plates but reported no arrests. They also are searching for three West German women terrorists, one of them wanted in the shooting and injuring of at least two policemen.

The Dutch search for Schleyer started Sunday after West German officials tipped police that Schleyer might be held by members of the Red Army faction — the Baader-Meinhof Gang — on a boat in Dutch waters.
